- 1. Confirm that your Tazer JL Mini is running the current firmware.
- 2. Install the Atlas Transfer Case.
- 3. Set the DTCM setting in the Offroad submenu to "No."
- 4. Navigate to the "4Lo" option in the Performance submenu.
- 5. HOLD the steering wheel Left Arrow button and PULL the high-beam stalk towards you with your left hand and TAP the Cruise Cancel button with your right hand.
- 6. The screen will read "FullTCase: Yes." Select this option and it will change to "FullTCase: No."
- 7. Perform a Full Reboot and two sleep cycles as described on the Critical Information page of the manual.

The transfer case is now set to part-time in order to work with the Atlas Transfer Case.
